 **Eligibility**

- Be a citizen of the African countries
- Be enrolled in the second to fourth year as an undergraduate student in the university/college located in African countries
- Be fluent in English
- Be mentally and physically healthy
- Have the ability and willingness to adapt to Korean culture and life in Korea
- Study a major related to Animal Biotechnology
- All applicants must be in good health, both mentally and physically, to participate the training program.

If an applicant is found to be in one of the following conditions while taking a medical checkup in Korea, the applicant will be returned to her or his country:

- Contagious diseases such as tuberculosis (TB), flu, Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, HIV/AIDS etc.:
- An applicant is tested positive on drug tests:
